CRITERIA SHEET

An applicant may complete the below application on the Granite State Detachment website or may download this file for a fillable form and mail to the address above, with a postmark no later than **15 April**.

Scholarship amount: One-year scholarship in an amount of up to \$2500 for expenses directly related to attendance at school—tuition, fees, room and board—paid to the student after the student provides proof of enrollment.

Criteria: This is a competitive scholarship for one involved, well-rounded, high-achieving student. Grades and course work, extracurricular involvement, family commitments, employment, and personal recognitions will be considered when selecting a recipient.

All applicants must complete and sign the application to be considered for this award, must supply requested proof of acceptance or written intent to attend an accredited trade school, must submit an official high school transcript, and meet the due date for the application.

Eligibility: Students who are currently enrolled as a high school senior with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and who meet one of the criteria in paragraphs A-C, below:

- A. Child, stepchild, grandchild, step-grandchild, great-grandchild, or step-great-grandchild of a current dues paid Regular or Associate Member of the Granite State Detachment Marine Corps League 542. The applicant's legal residence does not need to be in the Granite State Detachment 542 area of membership noted below.

- B. Child or stepchild of an active duty or reserve member of Company B, 1st Battalion, 25th Marine Regiment or Marine Corps Recruiting Substation Manchester, NH. Member is defined as active duty or reserve duty Marine, FMF Corpsman, or Navy Chaplain permanently assigned to one of these units. Neither the unit member's nor the applicant's legal residence must be in the Granite State Detachment 542 area of membership noted below.

- C. Child or grandchild of a current member or veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Marine Corps Reserve, U.S. Navy FMF Corpsmen, or U.S. Navy Chaplains. The applicant's legal residence must be within the area of membership noted below.

Notes:

1. Students currently enrolled in high school programs in public schools, private schools, parochial schools, charter schools, and those who are home schooled are eligible to apply, irrespective of where their school is located as long as their legal residence is within the area of membership.
2. The Granite State Detachment of the Marine Corps League area of membership is as follows:
